What is the CLASS?

The Classroom Assessment Scoring System (CLASS):

- Is an observational instrument developed at the University of Virginia to assess classroom quality
- Describes multiple dimensions of teaching that are linked to student achievement and development
- Has been validated in over 2,000 classrooms
- Can be used to reliably assess classroom quality for research and program evaluation
- Provides a tool to help new and experienced teachers become more effective; and
- Is being used as part of the innovative professional development tool, MyTeachingPartner, focusing on improving the dimensions of Quality Teaching.

What does training involve?

The CLASS is a multifaceted observation system that requires training for appropriate use. Training includes a set of pre-training exercises you complete on your own and two full days of training in which we cover background information on the CLASS and provide opportunities to practice scoring on videotaped segments. At the end of the training we will give a reliability test. Those who pass the test will be certified as CLASS coders. Additional training materials will be made available to people who do not meet the reliability criteria. The training will run from about 9:00 to 5:00 each day. A light breakfast and lunch will be provided.

What is the cost of training?

The charge for the 2-day training is \$670 per person. Included in this fee are all training materials, as well as breakfast and lunch on the two training days. Trainees are responsible for travel, accommodations, and dinner. Group rates are available for groups of five or more people.

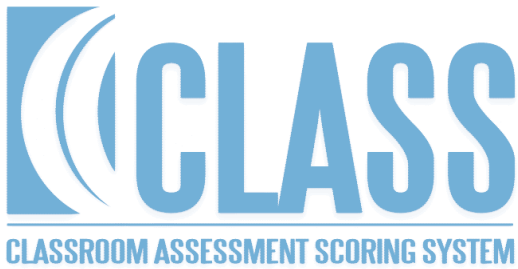

If you are interested in training others to use the CLASS, you will need to attend a Train-the-Trainers session. We will be holding a Trainers session in the two days immediately following this CLASS training, August 20th and 21st. The cost of the full 4-days is \$1,085.
